### **Background**

This symposium is an annual meeting that initiated, firstly, in Bogor in 2017 by a group of veterinary faculty representatives from Indonesia and Japan as initiators. ## ABSTRACT FORMAT

### Instruction to Authors

All papers (oral or poster) are to be submitted as **ABSTRACT** with the general format as follows :

**PAPER SIZE** : A4 ( 21 cm x 29.7 cm )

**MARGINS** : 1 inch top and bottom, 1.25 inches on sides.

**TITLE** : 12 pt **Calibri**, **CENTRED** and in **BOLD CAPITAL LETTERS**.

**AUTHOR(S) / AFFILIATION / EMAIL** : One blank line after the title shall be the initials and surname of the authors(s) in 10 pt Calibri, centered and in Bold Capitals. Follow by the name of the institution where the work was done in 10 pt Calibri, centered and in *Italics*. The email address of the corresponding author indicated with asterisk symbol (\*).

**ABSTRACT** : 12 pt Calibri, single spacing, justified on both margins of 2 to 4 pages long, including table(s) and figure(s) if appropriate.

### SUGGESTION FORMAT FOR THE ABSTRACT :

- i. Abstract: Short overview of the study.
- ii. Introduction: Background of the study.
- iii. Objective: The aim/goal of the study.
- iv. Method/approach: Techniques used in the study to achieve the objective.
- v. Results: A brief overview of the results with evidence to confirm the findings.
- vi. Conclusions: A brief summary of the study and implications.
- vii. References
- viii. Acknowledgment

**SIZE FOR POSTER** : 80 x 120 cm

**KEYWORD** : Maximum of 5 keywords to be placed below the abstract.

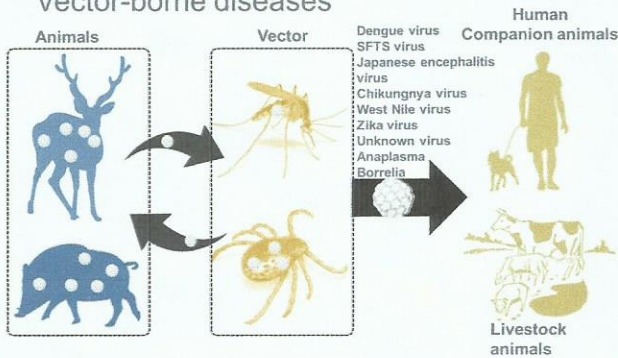

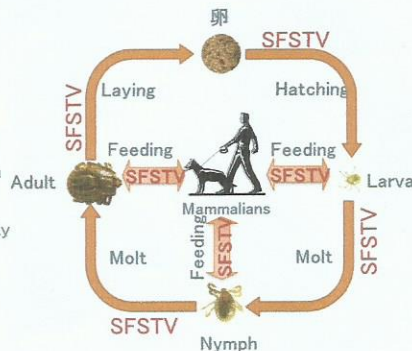

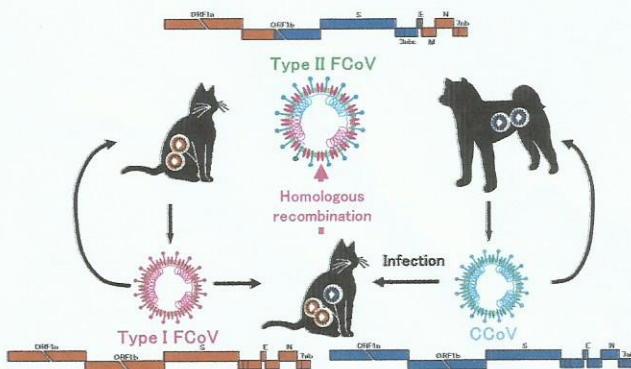


## Severe fever with thrombocytopenia syndrome virus (SFTSV)

- Also reported in Korea



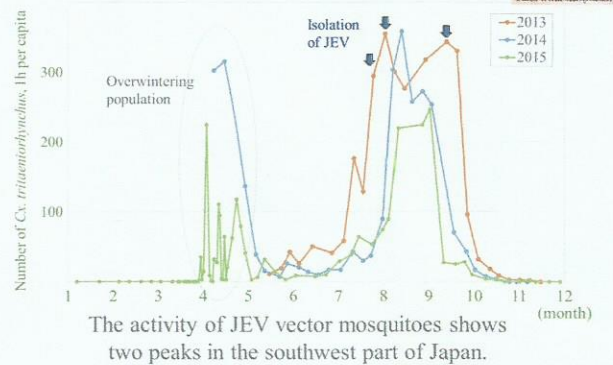
## Emergence of type II feline infectious peritonitis

## Number of JEV vector mosquitoes in cowshed of Japan (Yamaguchi)



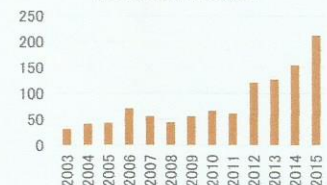
The activity of JEV vector mosquitoes shows two peaks in the southwest part of Japan.

## Hepatitis E virus (HEV)

- Family: *Hepeviridae*, Genus: *Orthohepevirus*
- Usually self-limiting, occasionally serious disease
- Genotype 1 and 2: In developing countries
- Virus contaminated water, endemic
- Genotype 3 and 4: In developed countries
- Zoonosis, sporadic infection

In 2003, HEV infection by consumption of deer meat was reported in Japan
