

ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

On 25 January 2018 at the 25th anniversary of the ASEAN-India Summit in New Delhi, the Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi announced 1000 fellowships for ASEAN citizens in the presence of all leaders of 10 ASEAN countries. The programme gives ASEAN citizens a choice to pursue a PhD at the internationally renowned IIT of their choice.

Strengthen the deep and historical relations between India and ASEAN. Applicants may apply online and the selected ones get a chance to finish-their PhD with funding at par with their Indian counterparts from the Government of India. The funding includes a monthly stipend and an annual research grant for up to 5 years of their PhD programme.
