COOPERATING AGREEMENT  
 BETWEEN  
 CENTER FOR ENVIRONMENTAL REMOTE SENSING,  
 CHIBA UNIVERSITY, JAPAN  
 AND  
 UDAYANA UNIVERSITY, INDONESIA



This Cooperating Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "CA") is made and entered into by and between the Center for Environmental Remote Sensing, Chiba University of Japan and Udayana University of Indonesia. Both of them (hereinafter referred to as "the Parties"), referring to the Agreement for Academic Exchange and Cooperation between Chiba University and Udayana University (hereinafter referred to as "UDAYANA"), signed on 20<sup>th</sup> of July 2007 (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement"), and the Extension of the Agreement, signed on 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2012, and pursuant to the prevailing laws and regulations of the respective countries, have agreed as follows:

ARTICLE 1  
OBJECTIVE

The objective of this CA is to jointly establish a center for research and education with mission specified below Article 2, the name of which is "Center on Food Availability for Sustainable Improvement" (hereinafter referred to as "CFASI").

ARTICLE 2  
CFASI

1. The mission of CFASI is to contribute to the realization of securing food availability and environmental conservation, through the analysis and diagnosis of food production and utilization with the use of spatial information, together with partners on a global basis.
2. CFASI shall be established in UDAYANA as one of centers of UDAYANA.
3. The details of activities, organization, management, operation and all other issues relating to CFASI shall be discussed and agreed by the Parties.
4. The Parties agree to collaborate with each other and to provide support necessary for the establishment and operation of CFASI. Details of such support shall be discussed and agreed in a separate agreement.

ARTICLE 3  
LIMITATION ON LIABILITY

Each Party agrees to waive any claim against the other Party with respect to damage or loss arising out of the activities under this CA, unless such damage or loss is caused by willful misconduct or gross negligence.

ARTICLE 4  
AMENDMENT

This CA may be amended at any time by mutual consent in writing by the Parties.

ARTICLE 5  
SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES


The Parties shall endeavor to resolve amicably any dispute concerning the interpretation and implementation of this CA. Any unresolved dispute shall be settled by means of direct negotiations between the Parties.

ARTICLE 6  
ENTRY INTO FORCE, DURATION AND TERMINATION

1. This CA shall enter into force upon the signature by the representatives of the Parties.
2. This CA shall remain in force for period of 5 (five) years and may be extended by mutual written consent between the Parties for certain number of years.
3. This CA might be terminated by either Party, subject to written notice of at least 6 (six) months in advance.
